HAPPENINGS ON BROADWAY

Broadway United Methodist Church, at the corner of Broadway and Amelia, would like our neighbors to know about these upcoming events:

"The Word on Broadway" is a series of free concerts that include classical, sacred or theater music tied to a theme of current social interest. The first presentation was "The City Beautiful" which spoke to the problems of racial justice and harmony. A special offering was taken, and Hillcrest Elementary received this first donation. When Pastor Tracy delivered this offering, the principal at Hillcrest was overwhelmed with this act of generosity. The offering taken at future presentations will be given to other well-deserving non-profit organizations.

On December 6 at 7:30 p.m., the presentation will be "Can I Be Home for Christmas" with the emphasis being acceptance. All genders, racial and ethnic groups and persons of all political persuasions are welcome.

"The Hanging of the Greens/Harp Concert" is an annual event at Broadway UMC. This year's presentation will be Sunday, November 29, at 3 p.m. This event is a presentation of Christmas music from the Central Florida Chapter of the American Harp Society and an explanation of the decorations in the church for the Christmas season by Rev. Tracy Hunter. The Harp Society usually has harpists from all over Central Florida, with more than 20 harps involved.

"The Heart of Christmas" will be the annual Cantata. This choral presentation is the combined choirs of Broadway United Methodist, St. Andrew's United Methodist and Reeves Memorial United Methodist. This event will be held at Broadway during the 11 a.m. worship service on December 13. If you have not heard a full choir sing at Broadway, you will be pleased and surprised with the wonderful acoustics in the building.

"Blue Christmas: Remembering Those We Miss" will be held Wednesday, December 16, at 6 p.m. This is a meaningful service for those who find the holidays a stressful time of year due to any kind of loss in their life.

Christmas Eve - Lessons, Carols & Candle lighting will be held Thursday, December 24, at 5 p.m.

An organizational meeting for all interested in participating in a community garden will be December 7 at 7 p.m. in the fellowship hall. The church will provide land for the garden in the grass area behind the paved parking lot. Even if you're not interested in actually growing plants but are a master gardener, please plan to attend as your skills will surely be needed.
