The Parade

Expected to attract approximately 15,000 spectators from Dublin and surrounding cities, the parade is a wonderful opportunity to demonstrate Dublin community pride with red, white and blue and to promote area events, programs, services and products.

Parade Schedule

The parade will begin promptly at 11 a.m. Monday, July 4, 2005 and last approximately 90 minutes. If selected, your group will be showcased along with local dignitaries and the 2005 Grand Marshal in a picturesque parade from Metro Center to Historic Dublin.

Civic Associations wanted for Parade

Dublin neighborhoods are encouraged to show their patriotism in the 2005 Independence Day Parade by building a float or organizing a patriotic-themed brigade. Associations are encouraged to develop a creative theme, which represents the uniqueness of their neighborhood.

The theme should be carried out through the association members' attire, decorated bicycles, wagons, vehicle or other creative parade entry. The City of Dublin will provide each participating civic association with a decorating kit and banner displaying their association's name. The brigade should be lead by two association members carrying the banner. The brigade can range from kids on decorated bikes to a neighborhood under red, white and blue umbrellas to a silly Uncle Sam theme.

Floats and brigades will be judged based on three categories: best float - \$250 prize; most creative brigade - \$200 prize; and most association attendees - \$175 prize. Prize money can be used towards civic association activities or neighborhood entryway improvements.
