TERMS OF OFFICE

All officers of this association shall hold office for 2 years

REMOVAL OF OFFICERS:

Removal of any officer will be by a 2/3 rd vote of the board excluding the person being removed.

VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF PRESIDENT:

In the event of a vacancy in the office of president, the vice president shall become president, until a replacement can be voted in.
