BURGLARY/THEFT PREVENTION

Crime Information:

Your area has been experiencing a series of residential burglaries. Suspect(s) target unlocked windows, sliding glass doors on balconies, and unlocked doors.

How you can help:

ALWAYS LOCK AND SECURE WINDOWS AND DOORS WHEN LEAVING
(Even if just outside or on a short errand)

KEEP ISOLATED AREAS WELL LIT
(Sensor lights and motion detectors surprise and deter criminals)

BURN PORCH LIGHTS THROUGH THE NIGHT
(Energy-saving lights will keep electric bills down)

ALWAYS HAVE MAIL AND NEWSPAPER DELIVERY SUSPENDED
(If you will be gone a week or longer)

WRITE DOWN THE LICENSE PLATE NUMBER
(If you see a suspicious vehicle casing your block)

NEVER OPEN YOUR DOOR TO STRANGERS
(Always ask City & Utility workers for identification)
