Application Form

Through your Neighborhood Association, District Council representative, and the San Antonio Police Department, you can be an asset to your police service area by becoming a member of a neighborhood based group, Cellular On Patrol (COP). This crime watch program will consist of responsible citizens patrolling with cellular phones that have a direct line to emergency assistance. To become involved with COP, you must attend two separate four-hour classes, scheduled approximately one week apart, totaling eight hours training. You also have the opportunity to ride along with a police officer for up to eight hours. Affiliation with a neighborhood association is not required. A cellular phone will be furnished to a designated COP participating group. For more information about the COP program, please call your Neighborhood Association President, District Representative, or the Police Department Service Area closest to you.
