RULES -- Refer to CC&R's, Article IV.

Trailers and Motor Vehicles: Recreational vehicles (mobile homes, boats, trailers of any kind, truck

camper, etc.) may not be kept, placed, maintained, constructed, reconstructed or repaired on any property or street within Heather Place in such a manner that will be visible from neighboring properties. This

includes vehicles rated greater than three quarter (3/4) ton.

Trash Containers and Collection: Trash containers should be stored from view, in your garage or rear

yard, except for collection. In accordance with the City of Chandler, trash containers MAY NOT BE PUT OUT FOR COLLECTION ANY EARLIER THAN 6:00 P.M. the evening prior to collection and must be BROUGHT BACK IN THE DAY OF TRASH

COLLECTION.

ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE RULES -- refer to CC&R's, Article IV, Section 4, page 31:

Exterior Accessories: No individual window, door or other treatments which are visible from

any other lot or common areas, including without limitation, shutters, shade screens, mirrors or other reflective covers, or "add on" front lighting shall be permitted without the prior written consent of the

Association Board.

Exception: Low voltage accent lighting normally does not

require approval.

<u>Basketball Standards</u> Free- standing basketball standards may be placed upon the lot

and Similar Structures: provided they are maintained in good condition by the Owner. No

basketball hoops are permitted to be attached to a dwelling or garage.

<u>Front Porch Patio</u>: Furniture placed for extended use or decor must be of the park bench

style and first approved by the Board on a case-by-case basis.

Holiday Lighting Exterior lighting and decorations commercially available for

and Decorations: home use normally do not require Board approval. Special designs and

those of large magnitude may be approved on a case-by-case basis and must have neighbor approval. Decorations must be removed no later

than thirty (30) days after the end of the holiday period.

Screen Doors: Screen doors must be "Security" rated by the manufacturer and

approved by the Association Board. Security screen doors must match

the color scheme of the door or window frame.
