CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

NORTH TARRANT PARKWAY (from Rainy Lake Drive to US 377)

May 8, 2006

This project involves the roadway construction for North Tarrant Parkway from IH-35W to US 377. North Tarrant Parkway will be widened to a four-lane divided roadway with storm drain and traffic signal improvements.

The following information has been provided by Austin Bridge & Road, L.P., the contractor for North Tarrant Parkway from Rainy Lake Drive to US 377:

- > The new traffic signals at Taggart Trail, Trace Ridge Parkway, and Park Vista Boulevard will begin operation on Wednesday or Thursday this week.
- > Park Vista Boulevard will be opened up to four lanes when the traffic signal is turned on.
- > The new traffic signal at Parkwood Hill Boulevard is scheduled to begin operation late next week.
- > Union Pacific Railroad will not complete the installation of their new railroad gates at US 377 until the first week of June.
