2006 SUMMER RECREATION CAMPS

DATES: Seven, one week sessions will be offered from June 19 through August 4. Camps will not operate on July 3-4.

REGISTRATION: Enrollment is limited and pre-registration is required. A non-refundable, \$25 deposit is required for each session; the remainder of the payment is due in full two weeks before each session starts. Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

OPEN HOUSE: Wednesday, March 22; 4pm – 8pm at the Gilliam Building, 77 Reads Way, New Castle, DE. Staff will be on hand to accept registrations and answer any questions you may have.

SCHOLARSHIPS: A limited number of need-based scholarships are available for the full day camps. Applications are provided upon request.

ACTIVITIES: Daily camp programming includes arts & crafts, fitness and nature activities, sports games and contests, and special visitors.

FIELD TRIPS: Full day camps include two field trips per week. Children will be transported to sites that offer bowling, ice skating, miniature golf, roller skating and swimming, and to programs at Ashland Nature Center, Brandywine Zoo, Carousel Park, Hagley Museum, and Rockwood Park. The field trips at each camp location will vary, and not all camp locations will travel to all of the listed program sites.

CAMP LOCATIONS

Talley Day Park – Full day camp (9am – 3:30pm) with Early Bird service available at 7:30am. The natural surroundings of Talley Day Park are combined with the Brandywine Hundred Library to provide a fun-filled camp with educational opportunities. Nature hikes and library programs will be offered throughout the week. A camp t-shirt is provided; parents should supply their child with a non-refrigerated bag lunch and drink each day.

Hockessin PAL and Garfield PAL – Full day camps (9am – 3:30pm) with Early Bird service available at 7:30am and PAL open recreation till 6:00pm. New Castle County and The Police Athletic League of Delaware have combined resources to offer camps at our two PAL facilities. Children will become PAL members (no cost) and be eligible to participate in all PAL programs throughout the year. Transportation will be available from the New Castle area to the Garfield Park location. A camp t-shirt is provided; parents should supply their child with a bag lunch and drink each day.

Weekly Cost: \$70, \$95 with pre-care

Banning Park – Full day camp (9am – 3:30pm) with Early Bird service available at 7:30am. Banning Park offers the perfect location for a summer camp with open fields, a large playground, wooded trails and two ponds. Hiking and sports programs will be offered throughout the week. Transportation will be provided from the Newport, Belvedere, Elsmere, and Richardson Park areas. A camp t-shirt is provided; parents should supply their child with a non-refrigerated bag lunch and drink daily.

St. Andrews School – Full day camp (9am - 3:30pm) with Early Bird service available at 7:30am. New Castle County and the Town of Middletown have combined resources to offer this unique, wooded, lake-front site providing an ideal camp setting that will include swimming, nature activities and plenty of kids games. A camp t-shirt is provided; parents should supply their child with a non-refrigerated bag lunch and drink each day.
