What: A place to meet with your fellow evacuees from the gulf area, get up to date information, ask questions, have your children play in a wonderful park outside, enjoy snacks and drinks and read the *New Orleans Times- Picayune*.

When: Open every Friday from 10:00 a.m. -4:00 p.m.

Directions:

By car—Drive to Havana which is E of Lowry. Go to 700 S. Havana and turn E onto Exposition. There is a huge American flag on the corner. The Expo Center is 3 blocks east on the left side.

By bus—Call RTD at 303 299-6000. Give them your starting address and the Center address of 10955 E. Exposition in Aurora. RTD will tell you exactly which buses to take and where to make transfers.
