## **DOG CONTROL**

Pleasant View Estates is covered by the El Paso County Dog Control Resolution No. 78-136, which is strictly enforced!

This means that <u>ALL DOGS IN OUR AREA ARE REQUIRED TO BE</u>
<u>LICENSED, AND ARE NOT ALLOWED TO RUN FREE</u>. License applications and enforcement is handled by the Humane Society of the Pikes Peak Region, 633 S. 8<sup>th</sup> Street, Colorado Springs, CO 80905 (473-1741).

License application forms, which contain details of Resolution No. 78-136, can be obtained from: (1) your veterinarian, (2) the Humane Society, or (3) the President, PVSC. Licenses are good for one year, renewable annually from the date of issuance. The Humane society notifies pet owners when it is time to renew them. Once licensed, dogs must wear license tags at all times.

Apart from normal random patrols, the Humane Society asks Pleasant View area residents who spot loose, annoying, or excessively barking dogs to call them promptly at 473-1741! They respond to such calls Monday through Saturday, 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. They will also respond to emergency calls 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Sundays and holidays. Impounded dogs may be reclaimed at the Humane Society kennels at 633 S. 8<sup>th</sup> Street upon payment of applicable fines (which can be expensive depending on circumstances).
