Bonnycastle: A Historic Neighborhood

The Bonnycastle neighborhood began its existence when a portion of the 158-acre Walnut Grove Farm established by Isaac Everett in 1848, then owned by John & Harriet Everett Bonnycastle, was sold in 1872 as the Sherwood Subdivision.

Much of the neighborhood was built prior to 1912 as street car service was extended byond Highland Avenue along Bardstown Road.


The Olmsted firm designed the subdivision following the completion

of Cherokee Park. These subdivisions were planned to provide lots overlooking the park. Frederick Law Olmsted provided four entrances to the park along Cherokee Road between Eastern Parkway and Speed Avenue. (*BHA Plan 2002*). The neighborhood was listed in the National Register of Historic Places in 1983, being designated part of the Highlands Historic Preservation District.

We wish to preserve the character and integrity of the neighborhood.


BHA Medallion dedicated
