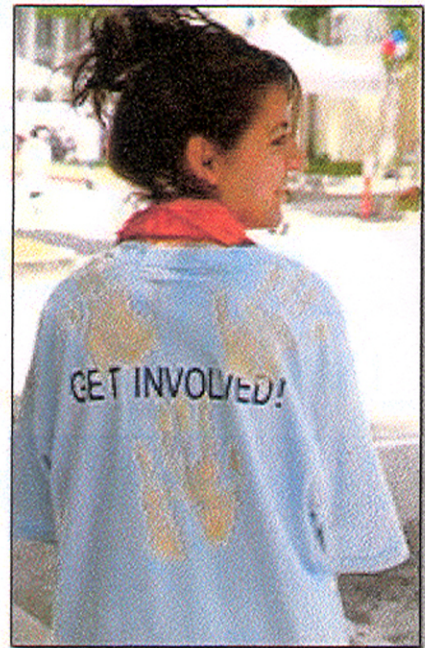
Great American Clean Up Weekend
