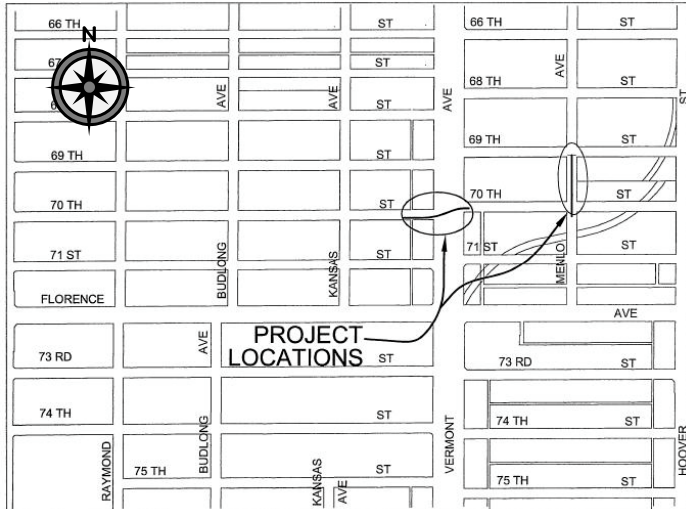

# Menlo Avenue - Vermont Avenue Storm Drain



## PROJECT OVERVIEW

Construction of storm drain systems along Menlo Avenue between 69<sup>th</sup> and 70<sup>th</sup> Streets, and on 70<sup>th</sup> Street between Vermont Avenue and the alley to its west. Work will also include construction of catch basins, lateral pipes, maintenance holes, and transition/junction structures.

## PURPOSE

The new storm drain systems will alleviate flooding in the area by directing flow from the intersection of Menlo Avenue and 70<sup>th</sup> Street to an existing storm drain on 69<sup>th</sup> Street, and from the intersection of Vermont Avenue and 70<sup>th</sup> Street to an existing storm drain at the alley west of Vermont Ave.

## WORK SCHEDULE

Summer 2007 through spring 2008, Mondays through Fridays

Work on Vermont Avenue will occur from 9:00 a.m. through 3:30 p.m.

Work on Menlo Avenue and 70<sup>th</sup> Street will occur from 7:00 a.m. through 4:00 p.m.

## CONSTRUCTION METHODS

Excavation and open trenching

At least one traffic lane in each direction will be open at all times.
