The Purpose

The goal of this children's bereavement camp is to provide an appropriate emotional outlet for Rhode Island children and adolescents, ages 5-17, who have experienced the death of a loved one. Campers will be exposed to fun recreational activities and grief support.

The Need

Research indicates that children who experience the loss of a loved one are at a much greater risk for depression, suicide, poverty and substance abuse.

Children often feel isolated in their grief, but rarely receive bereavement intervention.

Hope for Children

Camp BraveHeart will help children understand that what they are experiencing, although painful, is perfectly normal. This experience will give children the chance to express those feelings in a variety of ways.
