Recent car break ins in our community



Several residents have reported that their cars have been broken into, with the lot between buildings 1 & 2 being the main location.

Here are some tips to you can use to prevent car break in or theft, whether you're here at home or out in the community:

- Don't leave anything in your car, especially iPods, cell phones, laptops and other items. You never know what a thief may consider valuable.
- Put your purse, briefcase or laptop in the trunk before you go to your final destination. You never know who's watching you and will break in to your trunk the moment you leave. One of our residents learned this the hard way last year.
- Never leave your car running or leave the keys in the ignition unattended.
- 4. Install an antitheft device.
- 5. Keep your car door locked at all times.
- 6. Don't store any extra keys (car, house) in your car.
- Don't keep registration in your car. You don't want thieves to know where you live.
- 8. Get removable electronic devices (CD players, GPS) so you can take them with you.
