Driver crashes pickup onto Mesa sidewalk

A man destroyed a city electrical box and irrigation cylinder early Sunday morning after he lost control of his pickup truck and drove it onto the sidewalk.

According to police reports Richard Kadrzynski was driving southbound when he lost control and hopped the curb on the west side of the street near the 2600 block of North Lindsay Road.

The 1995 Dodge pickup first hit the electrical box before striking a large cement irrigation cylinder and coming to rest in the southbound lanes.

Kadrzynski only sustained minor injuries but his passenger suffered fractures to the spine and ankle. Both were transported to Scottsdale Memorial Hospital.

No charges were recommended but police are waiting for toxicology reports on the driver.
