Old Business.

- Prop. K Project. Rec and Parks is following up with the City Engineer. The Plans are complete and were not prepared in a fashion that allows the City to obtain competitive bids in the current competitive contracting environment. Thus, the only option is to have the work done by General Services, the City Department which constructed the costly and much complained about ADA bathrooms and regarded access ramp to the children's play area.
- ➤ **Bluffs project.** Jessyca reported that the project has been delayed, pending completion of the funding package. Best guess is a start in September of 2009.

- ➤ California Incline Project. EIR still not revised. Cannot start until after completion of Bluffs project, *i.e.*, September 2010.
- ➤ **Neighborhood Character Study.** Hillside ordinance community meetings are starting this week.
- ➤ Eucalyptus Forest plan preparation report. Recreation and Parks is supposed to complete the Grove "clean up" this month. George said that a meeting is being set up by PAB Chair, Norman Cowie..
- ➤ Support for our Senior Lead Officer. Bob Bronstein reported that he was having trouble finding a place to donate the Board designated \$1000.00. The digital fingerprint scanners have been purchased out of Police budget funds. He will continue to search and check out other options including: "adopt a Fire Station" and a solar-powered traffic speed sensor.
- ➤ Canyon infrastructure priorities. This involves a formal request from our BOD to the City Council that our area receive some of the monies that the City should be getting from the Federal government. The Board authorized Mike Deasy and George Wolfberg to submit a request to the Council office to include repair of sidewalks, installation of stair railings and completion of the beach bike path.
- ➤ Potential closure of 4th Street Stairway. A Santa Monica community meeting was held to address concerns with the use of the 4th street median by physical trainers and inappropriate behavior on some adjacent property. No formal recommendations have been made..
- > Tsunami sign in front of the liquor store. Jessyca reports that the sign has been relocated to a safer spot.
- ➤ Entrada Traffic Issues, sidewalk extension at Adelaide. Jessyca will continue to follow-up on this. Concern was expressed about the new traffic light system at Entrada and San Vicente and the dangers of traffic backing up down the Entrada Hill. Marilyn and Leslie volunteered to come up with a list of problems/photos etc., as to the safety of this new light. George will then present it to the Santa Monica City Manager.

Other Business.

- ➤ **Beach Shower Issues.** George will follow up with the County regarding the Shower near the Volleyball courts. A new concrete pad has been installed from the shower to the walkway. The showers are difficult to turn on and a lower head is needed for children and to facilitate washing sand off of bathers' feet.
- ➤ **Speed Enforcement.** George announced that LAPD is stepping up traffic enforcement in the general Palisades area as a result of community demand following the traffic death of a teenager, Nicholas Rosser, on Palisades Drive on January 31. There will be "zero" tolerance for violations.
