Cockrell, Jr., Chief of Police James Barren, Ph.D., and various community and business leaders will all come together to celebrate Detroit Police Department's grand opening of four (4) new police mini-stations scheduled for, *October 14, 2008*. An official ribbon cutting ceremony will take place at the police mini-station located within the Mack Alter Square Plaza (14700 Mack) at 1:00 p.m. The three other facilities joining the Mack police mini-station as new additions to the Detroit Police Department are: the Riverbend Plaza police mini-station (13206 E. Jefferson), the St. John's Hospital police mini-station (22101 Moross), and police mini-station located within the Northwest Neighborhood City Hall (19810 Grand River). Each police mini-station will be manned by a combination of sworn Detroit Police officers, Detroit Police Reserve officers and community volunteers. The hours of operation are from 2:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m.
