vs. J-S Investments LLC. TMHC and
the board knows that anything
to do with this unit has got to
be oked by the attorneys of both
parties. J-S Investments LLC was
not even given the consideration
of being notified in writing before
this was done. Tampering or
destroying evidence is very
serious in nature and against
the law.

Because the supports for this balcony are under the subfloor and living room of the unit belonging to J-S Investments it is obvious as to who owns the supports and who's permission you need in order to cut them in half. I would suggest you don't proceed until my attorney or myself has given the ok.
