Petition to Save Homes and Trees on Park Rd., Protect the Edge of Sedgefield and Provide for Pedestrian Safety

We oppose the proposed construction of a sidewalk on the Sedgefield-side of Park Rd. between Poindexter Dr. and Sunset Dr.



- The project is unnecessary, destructive, and will not add to public safety.
- It is preferable to direct pedestrians to cross Park Rd. at intersections with lights.
