The Appeal Process is an opportunity for a Unit Owner to clear up misunderstandings, defend their position on a rule waiver request, and/or request additional time for corrective measures of a rule violation.

RULES VIOLATION APPEAL PROCESS

- 1. A Unit Owner may request a Council Review regarding a violation notice of the documented Rules and Regulations by submitting the Appeal Request Form*, either by postal mail or electronic means, within 10 (ten) days of notice of the violation, to the Property Manager or Council Contact.
 - At any time during this process, the Unit Owner may contact the Property Manager or Council Contact Member for assistance.
 - ➤ Appeal Request Form* will be included in initial contact letter.
- 2. A reply to the Unit Owner, verifying receipt of Appeal Request and scheduling a requested Appeal Hearing date and time, will be made within <u>10</u> working days from receiving the request, via electronic means or postal mail.
- 3. Owner may opt to waive a Council hearing and submit a request for a rule variance, via written or electronic means to the Property Manager or Council Contact.
 - ➤ Property Manager or Council Contact shall provide copy of request to Council members for review, prior to discussion, of the situation.
- 4. Council will review and discuss Appeal at the next scheduled Council meeting or a mutually agreed upon date and time. Electronic communication is an acceptable means of communication.
- 5. Owner will be notified via certified mail of Council's decision regarding the rule violation and/or fine assessment. Copy to be placed in Unit folder.

Council Decisions are Final.
