### **\*\* RECYCLE GUIDELINES \*\***

**\*\* All Recycle must be out by 6 a.m. on the day of your pick up \*\***

They cannot be in cans or hidden in or behind your trash, they must be clearly visible.

**\*\* All recycle must be put in our blue recycle bags otherwise it will not be picked up \*\***

**Put bags to the curb on opposite side of driveway from your trash.**

- Bags must be securely tied or will not be picked up.
- Recycle bags must be filled no more than  $\frac{3}{4}$  full.
- Recycle bags are picked up every other week by a separate truck.
- Bags must not exceed 40 lbs. in weight or they will not be accepted.
- All products may be put in one bag, nothing has to be separated
- All items must be thoroughly cleaned and labels removed (if applicable)

**\*\* Recycle bags not prepared by these guidelines will NOT be taken! \*\***

### **ITEMS WE DO NOT ACCEPT: (but may go in regular trash)**

**GLASS**, Household Batteries, Telephone Books, Empty Windshield Solvent bottles, Antifreeze & Oil bottles, Butter Containers, & Wax or Polyfilm Cardboard

### **\*\* ACCEPTABLE RECYCLE MATERIAL \*\***

**Cardboard**: (place in recycle bag) or flatten down, bundle together and place it with recycle bag & mark recycle—we accept all corrugated cardboard-(cereal boxes/gray board etc.)

**Aluminum**: (clean and remove all labels if applicable)

**Tin**: (clean and remove labels if applicable)

**Plastic # 1 and #2**, (clear plastic bottles, juice containers, milk jugs, etc)

**Paper products**- (cardboard magazine inserts must be separated before put in bag)

**Newspaper** - (must be in OUR BLUE recycle bags)

**All Styrofoam (including Peanuts) & Colored HDPE #2** -- (Shampoo & Conditioner bottles)
