


Thank you for choosing the Rustic Canyon Summer Camp! We are excited to have you with us and are dedicated to your child's safety, security, and happiness.

#### DIRECTIONS TO RUSTIC CANYON







#### **RUSTIC CANYON SUMMER CAMP 2009**

#### Please read carefully before you sign:

Campers must be signed into and out of camp and extended care daily by a person who has been authorized by you. Any person authorized to pick up must have their name on file with the Recreation Center. Rustic Canyon Recreation Center is not responsible for children before or after day camp unless they are currently enrolled in Extended Care. Written permission must be provided if you wish your child to be released to anyone other than those authorized on the registration form. We will check identification.

Children not signed out of Summer Camp by 3:45 p.m. will automatically be placed in Extended Care and charged \$7.00 per hour. Campers who are not signed out by 5:30 p.m. will be placed in the recreation center office and charged a late fee of \$10.00 for every 15 minutes or portion thereof. This applies to all children unless they have written parental permission (see below) to sign themselves out of camp. Children in Preschool Camp who are not picked up within 15 minutes of camp ending for the day will be charged \$10 for every 15 minutes or portion thereof.

I understand that my child must wear the appropriate Camp Shirt. Children not wearing the proper shirt will be given one and charged \$10.00. I understand that all children must ride the charter bus provided by the Recreation Center. There will be NO drop-offs or pick-ups at the trip sites. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Staff is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please write your child's name on their belongings. 
