



Tortilla Soup

1 cup cooked chicken

11 oz. com

1 can chicken broth

1 can fat-free refried beans

1 can black beans (drained & rinsed)

3/4 cup salsa

2 cups lite cheddar cheese

Combine first six ingredients. Heat until beans are melted. Stir in one cup of cheese. Remove from heat.
