

## Oakland City Security Patrol Update – July 2009

- So far ten residents in the Oakland City and Westridge/Sandtown communities have signed up for the Security Patrol. A minimum of 60 subscribers is needed to launch the Patrol (and maybe even more if the majority of the subscribers are seniors since they pay a reduced rate).
- Letters will be sent during the week of July 20 to everyone who has submitted a signup form to give them an update on the Security Patrol.
- A minimum of <u>three</u> people are needed to serve as coordinators of the Security Patrol.
   The three people will come from all of the communities participating, not just Oakland City.
  - 1. One person will communicate with the Security Patrol Officer to schedule shifts, produce reports, and field inquiries from subscribers
  - 2. One person will be responsible for managing the budget of the Security Patrol, including collecting payments from subscribers and paying the Security Patrol Officer
  - 3. One person will be responsible for marketing the Security Patrol and recruiting new subscribers
- The Westmont Estates community has been invited to join the Security Patrol.
- The name of the Security Patrol will likely be changed now that the coverage area has been expanded.
- Next steps for the Security Patrol during the next 30 days include:
  - O Meet with APD Zone 4 to obtain a list of officers who might be interested in working for the Security Patrol
  - O Interview interested officers
  - Order and distribute Security Patrol signs for those who have already submitted the \$10 registration fee
  - O Identify the Security Patrol Coordinators
  - O Aggressively market the Security Patrol in Oakland City, Westridge/Sandtown, Bush Mountain, and Westmont Estates
