Keep Your Property Safe

According to the Louisville Metro Police Department, theft from automobiles continues to be a problem. Thieves are not only taking property from cars, they are spray painting them and vandalizing them as well.

The police recommend the following precautions:

- Do not leave valuables in sight inside your vehicle
- Remove wallets, purses, cash, and credit cards from your vehicle
- Keep your vehicle in your garage whenever possible
- Keep your vehicle locked at all times
- Utilize your vehicle alarm if applicable
- If you must leave valuables in your vehicle, secure them in your trunk

Another deterrent is to leave your front porch light on at night. Install an outside motion detector light on all sides of your home. Energy-saving CFL bulbs are better for the environment and in the long run, less expensive.

While on vacation, it is a good idea to stop your paper and mail, (or use Four Seasons Teen Help Group, see back page) set up lights on a timer and inform your neighbors that you will be out of town.

Call 911 to report all suspicious activity, no matter how unimportant it may seem.

- Four Seasons Neighborhood Association has contacted Graham Honaker about the tall grass and weeds by the railroad tracks on Raintree Drive. In the meantime, if anyone is interested in volunteering their time to cut the grass on Raintree Drive, the neighborhood would be very appreciative.
- The District 11 newsletter reports **Metropolitan Sewer** District will soon begin construction to improve drainage along the right of way on Manner Dale Lane and Six Mile Lane. MSD will be laying pipe and installing yard drains along parts of Manner Dale Lane and Six Mile Lane. Construction of the project will occur between June and September.
- Property at the intersection of Breckenridge Lane and Hikes Lane may be developed soon.

Representatives from Frisch's Restaurants met with neighbors about their plans for the intersection. The property will require a conditional use permit to allow for parking at the restaurant. If the case is approved by the Metro Board of Zoning Adjustment, construction on the restaurant may begin in early 2010.

Caribbean Summer Salad

- 1/4 c. orange juice 2T lime or lemon juice
- 1T honey 1/8 c. onions 1/4 tsp. red pepper
- 1/2 tsp. Seasoned Salt 1 tsp. thyme leaves
- 1/2 tsp. ground Allspice 2 medium nectarines or peaches cut into small cubes • 2 c. whole kernel corn • 1 can (15 oz.) black beans (drained & rinsed)
- 1/4 c. chopped celery

Directions: In large bowl, blend juices, honey and seasonings. Thoroughly mix in fruit and vegetables. Serve immediately or chill up to 4 hours.


