



2009 FALL TREE SALE

The Town of Avon will be hosting a fall tree sale this year. The trees will be sold to individuals and neighborhood associations for use in common areas, around retention ponds, and along streets in the space between the sidewalk and the street. The Town will pay for the shipment of the trees and for renting an auger to dig the holes for street trees only. **Payment for trees is due at the time of the order; no exceptions will be made.**

Cost per tree: \$50

Available species for use as street trees and yards only: Red Maple, Skyline Honeylocust, Prairie Fire Crabapple, Sugar Maple, and Swamp White Oak.

Available species for use in yards only: Baldcypress

Tree Size: 1.5" in caliper, approximately 10' tall, and will weigh approximately 150 pounds

Order Start Date: August 1, 2009

Order Deadline: August 31, 2009

Tentative Pick-up Date: October 24, 2009

Trees that are not picked up on October 24th will be stored at the Avon Town Hall Maintenance Facility for three days. If they are not picked up within that time, they will be donated to the Town for use as street trees **without refund to the purchaser**. Delivery will be available for neighborhoods with large orders (more than 20 trees). Neighborhood associations are responsible for organizing a drop off site in their neighborhood and for planting all street and common area trees. Large order deliveries may be scheduled for a separate date, depending on the number of total trees sold through the sale and the number of large orders received.
