No-Bake Cookies



- 1/2 cup margarine
- 2 cups sugar
- 1/3 cup cocoa powder
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1/2 cup peanut butter
- 3 cups uncooked oatmeal (rolled oats)

In a saucepan melt margarine; add sugar, cocoa powder and milk and bring to a boil. Boil one minute. Remove from heat. Add vanilla, peanut butter, and oatmeal. Stir until combined. Place wax paper on cookie sheet and drop by teaspoonfuls onto wax paper. Refrigerate. Makes about 2 dozen cookies.
