<u>Instructions for Creating a Winter Wonderland</u> <u>at the Entrance to Osprey Pointe</u>

Christmas 2007

- 1. Lay 12-gauge cable on ground from receptacle to designated end point, allowing plenty of "play" in the cable to "snake" from tree to tree.
- 2. Tie a heavy weight on end of fishing line (still attached to the spool).
- 3. Heave the weighted end over the designated tree limb.
- 4. Remove the weight and attach the fishing line to the <u>female</u> outlet end of the string of lights. Cover the outlet openings to prevent water from entering.
- 5. Reel in the fishing line, hoisting the string of lights until the bottom-most light is 3-4" off the ground.
- 6. Drive a nail upwards into the tree so that the head is lower than the pointed end.
- 7. Wrap the spool end of the fishing line several times around the nail and tie securely.
 - <u>THEN AND ONLY THEN</u> do you cut the fishing line off the spool.
- 8. Cut the male plug end off the string of lights and splice the lights to the cable.
 - Cut the cable, strip the ends of the wires on both cut ends of the cable, and cut off the ground wire.
 - Then connect the black wires from the string of lights and both ends of the cable, then connect the white wires.
 - Secure with wire nuts, and seal with electrician's putty.
- 9. REPEAT, alternating and staggering the colors, until all lights are strung for designated receptacle.
- 10. Splice a heavy-duty male plug onto the receptacle end of the cable.
- 11. Cross fingers, plug in, and admire the fruit of your labor!
- 12. Dispose of trash properly.
