

Your Holy Spirit hasn't come into our minds yet, we have closed our eyes and ears to the Spirit's leading and used our energies for selfish gain.


We are so grateful that we can come before You with a sincere request for forgiveness and know the slate will be wiped clean. What a gift!



HOME AND YARD INSPECTION

he Annual Park Inspection will be done the first week in February. To avoid a Beautification Notice please do an inspection of your home and yard.

If the home needs power washing or painting please make arrangements prior to February 1st. Your yard will also be looked at for weeds, mulching, plant trimming and yard ornaments. The rules state only four ornaments in one yard.

Carports are permitted to have BBQ grills, bikes, a golf cart and patio furniture. Screened in areas of the home must be kept neat and clean - **Not used for storage areas.**

EXTRA PARKING

Please be reminded vacant lots are not for parking vehicles. <u>Violators will be cited.</u>

JUNK PICK UP

On Wednesday, January 27th, the maintenance men will do a park wide pick up curbside. Put all unwanted articles out. This precedes the Park Wide Inspection for February 1st - 5th.

DOG STATION

The dog drop station on Mt. Pleasant is out of bags. We need the cooperation of all the dog owners on the south side to use their own bags and deposit the waste in the container.

If anyone would like to donate small grocery store bags, please give them to the office. That would be helpful and then we could continue to supply the station ourselves. The bags purchased from the drop station company are way too expensive to supply the station ourselves. Prior to the install the residents used their own bags. The main purpose of the installation was to eliminate residents from depositing the bags in the Mt. Pleasant laundry, which was leaving an odor.





HAZ TO GO

On Wednesday, February 3rd, the <u>HaZ To Go</u> trailer will be at the Mt. Piney Maintenance Yard for collection from 9 AM to 12 PM.

Please take light bulbs, household cleaners, computers, and printers, TVs, paint, paint thinners, fertilizer, pesticides and automotive fluids to the trailer before 12 PM



RECYCLE BINS

The plastic and glass recycle containers located on Americana Drive continue to be a problem.

Colored plastic bottles are still being thrown in the bin. <u>PLEASE</u>: Clear plastic and white plastic is all that is accepted. **Glass Bottles**: No blue, green or brown.

MONDAY BRUSH

If tree branches or bushes are cut towards the end of the week and lay on the lawn until Monday – First, it looks unsightly, Second, the leaves fall off and make a mess for the maintenance people to rake. Perhaps you could **haul them** to the brush trailer on Americana Drive or **wait until Sunday** to do your trimmings for pick up on Monday.

GATE HOUSE:

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1ST 2010

If you are expecting visitors please call the gate with information so they will be admitted. If you do not call the gate, the gate person will call you and ask permission for them to be admitted.

They will be issued a temporary guest pass that will require them to put their copy in the mailbox at the gatehouse.

We continue to have problems with uninvited guests using our facilities and



dumping stations. Your cooperation in making this procedure effective would be appreciated by all residents.

Facts and Figures did you know... Energy saved from one recycled aluminum can will operate a TV set for 3 hours, and is the equivalent to half a can of gasoline.









DECEMBER NEWS!


This month promises to keep up the pace with all the clubs and their functions!

Reporting Clubhouse Wi-Fi Service Interruptions

band users have not been able to connect to the Internet when trying to use our Wi-Fi facility in or around the Clubhouse. Assuming your laptop computer is in good working order, there are two basic malfunctions that can prevent your Internet connection: 1.Our local Wi-Fi modem is temporarily inoperative, or 2. The signals from our provider, Knology, have been interrupted.



In the first situation, your computer will not display the Wi-Fi signal of our Cove Computer Club Modem, (normally at least a three bars of signal strength).

In the second situation, your laptop will display our Computer Club Wi-Fi signal, but you still cannot bring up any familiar web sites with your browser. In this situation, temporary loss of the Knology broadband feed signal is the most likely cause.

In either situation, the only appropriate remedial step is to contact our Cove Computer Club, President Mark Nixon, at (727) 528-0071. We hope that all of our Cove computer users will share this information with any laptop users that take the opportunity to enjoy Web access through our Clubhouse Wi-Fi facilities.

Exercise FACTS

came across an article recently in the December issue of the "Nutrition Action Health Letter" about exercise. I simply must share with you some of the facts from this issue. Here seven facts you may not know about exercise.

- 1. Exercise can curb your risk of Cancer!!! It is never too late to start.
- 2. Exercise creates new Brain Cells. Aerobic* activity is the key.
- 3. Exercise boosts insulin sensitivity. Both aerobic* and strength training are key factors in improving insulin sensitivity needed for our bodies fuel.
- 4. Creatine helps build muscle. It is a compound made from amino acids found in the liver and kidneys and is in the protein we eat. It helps increase muscle and bone strength.
- 5. Sitting can kill you. Studies have documented that people who sit for the majority of their day have a much higher mortality rates than people who don't even if they are physically active at some other time during the day. Advice: Keep moving.
- 6. One is never too old to build muscle. Many studies show one can build up muscles by regular strength and resistance training. It does not matter how old a person is or whether one is female or male.
- 7. Exercise prevents visceral fat gain which all of us get, as we grow old unless we do something about it. This is the fat, which builds up around the organs in middle. Much research shows aerobic* exercise will reduce visceral fat.

* The American College of Sports Medicine (ACSM) defines aerobic exercise as "any activity that uses large muscle groups, can be maintained continuously, and is rhythmic in nature." It is a type of exercise that overloads the heart and lungs and causes them to work harder than at rest.

With "keep moving" as the main advice from this article, we have an exercise class that does this. It meets in the Atrium, Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 8:15 AM – 9 AM. Our leader Sally Anderson, a certified person trainer, puts us through the paces of aerobic, strength, stretching, and weight exercises. Please join us.
