Grow old with me the best is yet to be.

Since I am writing this prior to election night, I may or may not be representing you as a Board Member at this time. Let me take this opportunity to say thank you to all, and for the most part, it truly has been a pleasure representing this great community.

On a more serious note, at the candidate's night one of the major questions was, "Would we, if elected, treat the renters any differently?" The question is how are they treated differently? They have the use of all amenities and clubs the same as all shareholders. They still cannot vote or work on the budget. I have stated that not since Clive Ballentine was the head of the Renters had any discussion been asked for or held. I was mistaken as we also had a good dialog with John Dunn and since I was not on the Board when Jean Dion was President, I cannot speak for that era. However, I can speak to the last two years. We, as I stated at the meeting, have not once been asked for a meeting with any of the Renters. We have however, been sued by one of the officers who lost his case as frivolous and another officer who dropped his case as soon as he saw it was a lost cause. It therefore appears to me that the officers who say they are representing the Renters but who were elected more than two years ago and did not hold an election last year would have an Agenda. The question "asks" why we do not treat the Renters better? Three renters attended the last meeting, all were said to be the officers. My question is whom do they represent; do they have a group of dues paying renters to represent or just themselves? We as a Board have no clue. The so-called President said to the manager he no longer was President, yet he conducted the meeting where "three" were in attendance.

My question is, WHY DO SOME FEEL THEY ARE TREATED AS SECOND CLASS CITIZENS?

Water Shut-offs:

The apologize for the recent water shut-offs that have occurred. Anyone spending the evening at the New Year's Eve festivities at the clubhouse enjoyed an interesting evening. The water was shut off and turned on intermittently as needed by the partygoers.

The five-inch water main broke on Mt. Pleasant on January 4th at 3 PM. The repair went smoothly and was fixed in just two hours.

We discovered through the Emergency water shut off of January 7th: We do NOT have the correct phone numbers of our residents. We also do NOT have our



Northern residents listed on the Hurricane Call List. We are attempting to find a solution so all residents can be notified at the same time.

Important Message:

Please be reminded that whenever an announcement is made about water being shut off, it is imperative that you *shut off your hot water heater!* Most of the time, if the heater is not on a timer, it needs to be done by shutting off the circuit breaker in your home, on the main electric breaker panel. Otherwise the heating element in the heater will burn out. MAROA is not responsible for the replacement of heating elements.

Anyone that has a GAS hot water heater does not need to shut off his or her electric or the heater.

Please call the office or gatehouse with any questions when the water is off: such as to the time frame for the time the water will be off.
