Committee Reports:

Eucalyptus Forest Plan, Randy Young, Chris Casady, Brian Norbury. Plans and renderings were presented by the designer, David Card. 40 new trees are promised by our partner the Friends of Scott Gerwehr, primarily eucalyptus. The plan anticipates an additional 14 new exotics. Separate irrigation levels will be required for the exotics versus the other new trees. Renderings of the two arbors prepared by Chris Casady were shown (one rendering will be in the newsletter. Tile samples were passed around. Mr. Norbury was acknowledged for the pro bono identification of the existing trees. Randy stated that the next step would be to get informal sign off by Rec and Parks before

seeking approval from Cultural Affairs. The final approval will be required from the Rec and Parks commission.

New Recreation Center Management. Erich Haas, the Senior Director at the Palisades Recreation Center had been given additional duties over the park as the retiring director, Dahna Hall will not be replaced.
