

1010.5 ACCUMULATION OF GARBAGE AND JUNK

SECTION ONE: It shall be unlawful for any property owner or resident of the City of Moorland to allow to accumulate on his or her property outside the residence any garbage, debris, trash or junk which is not contained in standard garbage containers.

SECTION TWO: For purposes of this ordinance, the words "garbage", "debris", "trash" or "junk" shall include, but shall not be limited to:

- 1) plumbing fixtures;
- 2) auto parts;
- 3) metal parts and machinery;
- 4) lumber;
- 5) paper.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall not apply to material being used in projects for which building permits have been issued by the City or for equipment being used in the construction of said project.

SECTION FOUR: Anyone who violates section One of this ordinance shall be punished for such violations by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) or more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each offense. Each citation shall constitute a separate offense.

1020.1 DESTRUCTION OF CITY PROPERTY

SECTION ONE: Should any city property willfully, negligently or otherwise be destroyed, the person or persons committing such injury shall report said damage to the marshall or his deputies who shall make a written report of the damage to the Board of Trustees.

SECTION TWO: Any person or persons destroying CITY PROPERTY shall be assessed the cost of replacing said property, including material and labor, and/or fined no less than \$10.00 or more than \$100.00 for each such injury.

SECTION THREE: The City of Moorland reserves the right to take any other necessary legal action against such person or persons who have destroyed City property to protect the interest of its citizens.

1030.1 FINES

SECTION ONE: The limits of fines for persons who violate the provisions of the ordinances of the City of Moorland shall be increased to, not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each offense.
