Your team will compete against other teams to assemble its computer the fastest. Each member on the winning team will receive a laptop computer. Your entry fee includes your registration fee for the Summit.

Renewal Energy Patro-Tech Game Show/Bring Your Own Team (High School, only)

You will have the opportunity to bring your own team of 3 (5 teams total) for the fee of \$70.00 per student, to enter in the Renewable Energy Patro-Tech Game Show.
