
SITE INFORMATION:

Situated in the midst of the exploding populations of Pickerington and Canal Winchester on Route 33, this 50 acre site has visibility from and access to Route 33, which has very high traffic volumes. Over 28,000 people commute from Fairfield County to Columbus daily and Route 33 is the main connector, serving over 80,000 cars. A new exit ramp system provides direct access to the site. Diley Road will be widened to four lanes over the next three years from Route 33 north to State Route 256 to absorb the large traffic volume coming from Pickerington to Route 33.
