

American Red Cross Learn to Swim Camp Cost: \$100 members/ \$125 non members

Camp Description:

Our American Red Cross Learn to Swim camp is designed to teach children ages 5-12 years old the fundamentals of swimming. The focus of the camp includes getting children oriented to the following:

- Buoyancy on front and back
- Water entry and exit (feet first and headfirst entries)
- Underwater exploration
- Swimming on front
- Swimming on back
- Kicking
- Water Safety
- Water Games
- Sun Safety
- Work on the 4 competitive strokes and turns when age/ ability appropriate.

Camps are 3 hours long and are organized in the following way:

- 45 minutes of learning
- 15 minute break (reapply sunblock, restroom, small snack or drink)
- 45 minutes learning
- · 20 minute snack break (reapply sunblock, restroom, etc)
- 30 minutes learning & water safety
- 25 minutes games & freetime, parent pickup

Our swimming camp instructors are American Red Cross certified Water Safety Instructors, with an additional background in coaching & competitive swimming. All campers will receive a camp T-Shirt and underwater photo of themselves.


