

Neighborhood Clean Up Day 2010-

The yearly neighborhood cleanup will be held this year on May 15th from 8:00 am to 2:30 pm in the Crosley Bowl parking lot. There are a few changes this year in allowable items. We can no longer accept electronic waste such as television sets, computers, monitors or laptops. These items may be recycled at the Goodwill store on Fourth Plain during business hours. Also, not allowed are concrete, roofing, hazardous waste, liquids, refrigerators or air conditioners. Please bring a utility bill as proof of address and sign in. The neighborhood association will be collecting donations for the general fund, picnic supplies and the Christmas party.

We are also collecting the following items in working and non-working condition:

- * Reusable items for the “free stuff” pile.**
- * Bicycles for the Community Cycling Center.**
- * Lawn mowers and gas powered equipment for LaCenter High School.**
- * Any type of scrap metal for recycling collected by InnerCity Hauling.**

Acceptable items include: furniture, small appliances, four automobile tires per household, paint cans (with dried paint and lids off), and two railroad ties per household. There will be separate lines for yard debris and trash, so try to separate your loads. If you have a truck, think about checking with your neighbors to see if they need help getting their stuff to the site!
