

WHO DO I CALL FOR HELP?

Here are some programs that have been set up to serve people who might need a helping hand. If you qualify, one or more of these programs may be just enough to help you make both ends meet.

✤ LOW COST HEALTHCARE FOR YOUR KIDS

If your children don't have health insurance and you can meet income guidelines (a family of four can make up to \$3,225 a month), call the K-CHIP Program at 1-877-K-CHIP-18 (<u>1-877-524-4718</u>).

✤ HELP WITH FOOD BILLS

Many people don't know they may be eligible for the Food Stamp Program. Recent improvements have been made in this old standby, call <u>595-4238</u>.

For "pregnant, postpartum and breast-feeding women, infants and children under five," you may be able to sign up for the WIC (Women Infants and Children) Program. Call the Health Dept. at <u>574-6676</u>. If for some reason you are not eligible for WIC (or if you are 60 or over), you may still be able to get some commodities (certain packaged foods). Call the Commodity Supplemental Feeding Program at <u>595-3031</u>.

If you need an emergency supply of groceries, you could call Dare to Care (DTC) at <u>966-3821</u> for the DTC site nearest you.

TAX "REFUND"

If you have no children, worked and earned about \$12,120 or less, or if you have children and eamed \$36,348 or less, you may be eligible for thousands of dollars from the government. Call <u>581-7262</u> to find out about the Earned Income Tax Credit and also how you can get your tax returns filled out for **FREE**. In addition, disabled and elderly (over 65) homeowners may be eligible for a break on their taxes – call <u>574-6380</u> and ask about the "Homestead Exemption".

✤ HELP WITH PHONE BILLS

If you don't have phone service, get in touch with BellSouth at <u>1-888-757-6500</u> and ask about their "Link-Up" Program for savings on hook-up charges. If you already have service, ask about their "Lifeline" service for a break on your monthly bill.

OTHER HELP

Call Louisville Metro Dept. for Human Services at <u>574-5050</u> and ask them to give you the number of the "Neighborhood Place" serving your neighborhood.
