



## Important 2010 Election Information for Oakland City Voters

### Important Dates

- Voter Registration Deadline for 2010 General Primary: **Monday, June 21, 2010**
- 2010 General Primary Election: **Tuesday, July 20, 2010**
- 2010 General Primary Election Runoff (if necessary): **Tuesday, August 10, 2010**
- 2010 General Election: **Tuesday, November 2, 2010**
- 2010 General Election Runoff (if necessary): **Tuesday, November 30, 2010**

### Georgia General Assembly

- State Senator, District 36 (includes Oakland City east of a line that starts at the intersection of Donnelly Avenue and Lawton Street, runs south on Donnelly, heads west on Richland Road, runs down Oakland Drive, heads west on Avon Avenue, and runs south on Lorenzo Drive) **Nan Orrock is the incumbent**
- State Senator, District 39 (includes the rest of Oakland City) **Vincent Fort is the incumbent**
- State Representative, District 55 (includes most of Oakland City) **Rashad Taylor is the incumbent**
- State Representative, District 61 (includes the southwest corner of Oakland City west of Lorenzo Drive and south of Avon Avenue) **Ralph Long is the incumbent**
- State Representative, District 63 (includes the northwest corner of Oakland City north of Richland Road) **Tyrone Brooks is the incumbent**

Independent candidates and candidates for non-partisan races (such as judges) will begin qualifying for the November General Election at the end of June.
