- 1. What is Clubhouse Exercise? It is an easy and fun way to do morning exercise via videotapes.
- 2. Where? In the Clubhouse, library area
- 3. **When**? Daily, Monday through Friday.
- 4. **What time**? 8 9 AM
- 5. **Why should I go?** To start your day by joining others who are motivated



- to exercise mornings in an easy and fun way that: can help you to gain better health, strength, balance, endurance, memory, tone up, breathe better, feel better, lose weight. I, personally, lost 60 pounds over a year and a half and I have maintained a healthy diet, exercise and lifestyle for almost 3 years now. IT IS POSSIBLE as, it happened for me, right here, in our very own, Americana Cove.
- 6. **Cost**? The Clubhouse Exercise Class is free. The water aerobics class here is free too and many of us leave right after the exercise class to change into bathing suits and join the water aerobics class, led by Sharon Miller. All this helps to keep the calories and metabolism burning
- 7. What do I bring with me to Clubhouse Exercise? Bring just yourself, or bring a family member or a friend with you and wear something comfortable. On Tuesdays and Thursday s bring your own, personal, light hand weights, or you can also borrow weights out of the Atrium closet but you must return them promptly after exercise. - 8. What is expected of me in exercise class? In the way that they feel, in their breathing, strength, endurance, balance, memory, co-ordination, or that they have lost weight, or toned up – all positive. I hope to see some of you, year rounders, to join me in my Clubhouse Exercise Class, right now, this summer and all year round.
