HAVE YOU NOTICED?????

There have been changes made to our neighborhood lately and some are pretty significant. The biggest change has been the new plantings at the 10th Street entrance. We have put in new plants and boulders at both ends of the median. Please take a moment to look at them; they look great!

The next thing that has progressed has been the 7th Street entry. So far, we have gotten the lights installed, a new water meter and water system and a soon to be installed street light. We still have to get plantings and grass put in to complete the area. Our hope is to have the area finished by the end of summer.

The one thing that you probably would not notice is the brick wall repairs done at both the 5th and 10th Street entrances. This work was necessary to maintain the integrity of the entrance walls. This type of repair is normal for brickwork that is about 15 years old.

RECYCLING

Oklahoma City citizens send more than 275,000 tons of trash to the landfill and recycle only 8,000 tons. That's only about 3% and that's not enough. Our neighborhood can help!

Just fill your recycling bin and set it out for pickup with the Big Blue cart. You can recycle aluminum (clean food and beverage containers and foil), glass (clean beverage and food jars and bottles), paper (newspapers, magazines, advertising inserts, junk mail and phone books), plastic (clean milk and detergent jugs, beverage containers and all containers stamped with any recycling symbol on the bottom), steel and tin (clean food cans and lids).
