Kirkwood At Arrondale HOA, INC Swimming Pool Rules

- 1) NO DIVING!
- 2) For safety reasons, NEVER swim alone! Persons who use the pool do so at their Own RISK!
- 3) No pushing, shoving, or running anywhere in the pool area.
- 4) The pool will be open for use from 7:00am-Sundown (Hours subject to change). Persons caught inside pool facility after hours or when gate is padlocked are subject to prosecution.
- 5) Pool tags <u>must</u> be visible at all times. Anyone without a current pool tag will not be granted access to or allowed to remain at the pool.
- 6) Only residents and up to 4 quests per household may use the pool. The homeowner/resident **MUST** accompany guests at **ALL** times! The homeowner/resident is responsible for the conduct of his/her tenants/guests at all times.
- 7) Children 15 years of age and under **MUST** be accompanied, supervised, and protected by a person at least 18 years old.
- 8) Children 16 & 17 years old are permitted to bring **ONE GUEST ONLY (guest must also be 16 or older)**, thus be prepared to show ID. This privilege may be revoked at any time!
- 9) No pool parties or similar gatherings are allowed at the pool facility without written consent from the Board of Directors. Homeowner will be required to obtain liability insurance if granted permission.
- 10) Everyone **MUST** shower before entering the pool.
- 11) Abusive language, intoxication, boisterous conduct, or vandalism will not be tolerated. Only radios with headphones are allowed.
- 12) **NO ALCOHOLIC** beverages permitted in the Toddlers pool area.
- 13) No glass bottles, containers, or other breakable objects are permitted.
- 14) No littering please put all trash in the containers provided.
- 15) No food or cooking equipment allowed in the pool area.
- 16) Proper swim attire must be worn in the pool. NO cut off jeans or other filter clogging clothing.
- 17) Life rings and other safety equipment are for Emergency Use Only.
- 18) Children not yet toilet trained must wear "Little Swimmer's" or equivalent type liners, and must be continually watched by their parent or guardian at least 18 years old. Should an "accident" occur, you must make every effort to remove the fecal matter promptly and immediately notify the Association's Management Company.
- 19) Anyone with contagious or communicable skin rashes or disorders is not permitted to use the pool.
- 20) No pets, bicycles, skates, or skateboards are permitted within the pool or fenced area.
- 21) Users of pool must be courteous and alert to any unsafe conditions.
- 22) Only <u>inflatable</u> floatation devices are permitted in pool. Please be courteous and refrain from use of flotation devices during peak hours. Members of the Board, Pool Committee, or the Attendant(s) reserve the right to have any flotation devices removed immediately at their discretion.
- 23) The entry gates must be closed each time you enter or exit the pool.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN YOUR POOL PRIVILEGES BEING REVOKED!
