

Please be informed by this message that a great number of business people who advertise in those publications are not registered with the office. We must have a copy of their business license and their company insurance.

When you have a power failure you must call the gatehouse to report it. We have an electric company on call to respond to power outages. Two of the three companies that this article is about were asked if they were licensed and insured with Americana Cove,

This policy was established many years ago to help protect our residents from fraudulent business practices. But it does not do you any good if YOU do not take advantage of the Vendor List the office keeps updated.



Weekly Newsletter (A History) Harrison Wilder Bullard, 1984



Believe it or not...this has been a regular feature since the FIRST WEEK the Park opened in 1961. It might be of interest that in the early days, one wasn't sure what color paper it would be printed on. It came in five delicious "Flavors"- green, blue, pink, yellow or white.

In 1978, after DeAnza took over, they informed us that they could not justify a weekly newsletter. Instead, they would issue a professionally printed monthly release, which would not carry some of the item that had been regular for years.



Residents asked to vote and stated they wanted the weekly letter to continue. Harold Stasch agreed to act as Editor, and his dedicated crew would type the stencils and print the copies. For five years this went on satisfactorily. Again, DeAnza offered to prepare a professional, printed monthly release at no cost to the residents. It was voted to give DeAnza a six-month trial. At the end of the trial, the residents voted to return to the weekly newsletter. Harold Stasch, with the help of Harrison Bullard, as co-editor, agreed again to be Editor and the same loyal crew of Evelyn Mittlesteadt, Jules Evans and Joseph Dillon agreed to carry on.




