

Some Worthy Projects under long range consideration by the Braintree Community Preservation Committee.

The seawall at Watson Park is in need of restoration as the years has taken its toll on it.

At first consideration the wall needs to be deemed historically significant, but at present there is no such designation. Much historical documentation needs to be forthcoming and presented to the Braintree Historical Society so that the wall may be considered and sanctioned as valued as historically significant to the Town of Braintree before the Committee can vote funds for its restoration.
