## Code Compliance Hot Tips: Dial 311

### Front & side yard parking

We are not allowed to park our vehicles on the front or side lawn unless there is a permanent surface of concrete, brick, asphalt or gravel with defined borders designated for parking.

indoor furniture, appliances, boxes or any other items.

### Noise

Contact SAPD for noise Violations with as much information as possible. Noise levels over 63 decibels are a violation in residential areas at any time of the day and night if they disturb your neighbors. As an example a lawn mower makes in average 90 decibels. Violators may be fined and referred to the Municipal Court.

### Junked vehicles

The City may fine and after notification tow and destroy any junked vehicle parked in a yard, street or any visible location.

### Outside storage

Outside storage is a violation of the City's zoning code. Yards should not be used as storage areas for vehicles, building materials, tires,
