# **Snow Priority Streets**

Our neighborhood is participating in the Snow Priority Street program. Signs like that shown on the right of this page will be posted in our neighborhood to remind residents.

#### What this means:

After any snow event of 1" or more snow accumulation, the city will plow the Snow Routes, <u>then</u> they will plow the "Snow Priority Streets". Finally, they will do the other residential streets. With their new wing plows, the city can do a street in 2 passes and decrease plow time by 33%!

This will help in many ways:

- Our streets will be plowed sooner
- No waiting for 4" before we get plowed
- Smaller drifts in your driveway
- Small amount of snow or ice left on the street, will be melted quickly on a sunny day
- Less ripples in the street left from going around cars

### What we need to do:

We need to get our cars off the street! If there is 1" accumulation, you need to be thinking about where your car is parked. The wing plows will not fit on our streets with parked cars. Tickets will be issued quickly and the fine is \$35!

We don't want you to be fined and the city doesn't want to call in the police to issue tickets because it takes time. Fliers were distributed that had details about how you can/will be notified.
