

The St. Louis Park Fire Department has begun the planning and logistical effort to complete the Live Fire Training on Tuesday, December 14, from 4:00 pm – 9:00 pm.

In order to provide the highest level of safety we will be required to shut down Goodrich to through traffic, between Yosemite and Wooddale during that time. We will do our best to allow access for residents on Goodrich. This is a change from what was discussed at the meeting. There is just no good way to supply the needed water without shutting down Goodrich in the area of the drills.

The attached map shows the layout of the apparatus and lines for the drills. We will have a primary line and a back-up line, from independent water sources (hydrants and apparatus) to make sure that safety is the highest priority.

At this time we will plan to have a Fire Department Vehicle, near the two apparatus, as your point of contact during the drill on Tuesday.

There will be a lot of work taking place over the next few days to get the structures ready for the Live Fire Training. We will do our best to keep vehicles off of Goodrich and keep you informed of what is going on.
