


January Prayer John Whittredge Hill, Chaplain


Mason Jones, MD By Gail Jones



ason Jones and his wife, Alice, live at 628 Mt. Lancaster in the winter months when they leave their house in Dayton, Ohio. During the spring of 2009 he was honored by the Good Samaritan Hospital in Dayton, Ohio for his sixty yrs. of nurturing his children, family and trees. He was a prominent pediatrician in that area during the 1940s, 50s and 60s. He grew up in Chillicothe, Ohio, in a loving family of nine children. After graduation from medical school in 1942, his pediatric training at Columbus Children's



Hospital - now Nationwide Children's Hospital - was interrupted by World War II. After serving two yrs. in the European Theater with the U.S. Army until the war ended in 1945, Dr. Jones returned to Columbus to complete his internship and then moved to Dayton, Ohio with Alice where he raised five children, Karen, Alan, Cindy, Kathy and Laura. As the retirement yrs. approached, Mason decided to purchase a farm and through the influence of his older brother Dick, who had a Christmas tree farm in New Hampshire, he purchased a 100-acre farm, planted Christmas trees, and it is now owned and operated by his daughter Laura and her husband David Rench. Country Pines is a very thriving business and families of two and three generations go out each year to choose their Christmas trees.






