Copper-Flower and Seneca Bicycle Boulevards





The Grant Road Task Force endorsed a recommendation to develop two bicycle boulevards that run parallel to Grant Road. The Grant Road parallel bicycle boulevards were recommended to the Task Force in response to public input received at community conversations, workshops, and open houses. The two bicycle boulevards will serve as bicycle-friendly alternatives to Grant Road bicycle lanes, and will incorporate improvement features that serve to prioritize bicycles over vehicular traffic including traffic calming, bicycle signage, pavement markers, signalized traffic control at intersections with arterials, and channelization. Two parallel bicycle boulevards are proposed: (1) Copper/Flower Bicycle Boulevard, and (2) Seneca Bicycle Boulevard. The Copper/Flower Bicycle Boulevard is proposed to extend from Fairview Avenue (western limit) to Swan Road (eastern limit) and the Seneca Bicycle Boulevard

is proposed to extend from Fairview Avenue (western limit) to Rosemont Boulevard (eastern limit).

The recommended preliminary routing for the two Grant Road parallel bicycle boulevards are:

- Copper/Flower Bicycle Boulevard: Kelso/Copper/Flower Street/San Carlos Place
- Seneca Bicycle Boulevard: Calle Sierra/Ventura/Seneca/Waverly/Justin Lane

The proposed route of the bicycle boulevards is shown in the map below. Page 2 and 3 show concepts of elements proposed to be constructed along the bicycle boulevards. The layout of these design elements along the bicycle boulevards is shown in pages 4 through 47. It should be noted that locations of signs and pavement marking symbols are only conceptual. This concept report will provide direction to the design of the bicycle boulevards which will commence once construction funds are obtained.
