NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Mayor and Council of the City of Tucson will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, March 8, 2011, at or after 5:30 p.m., in the Mayor and Council Chambers of City Hall, 255 West Alameda, Tucson, Arizona, at which time and place all interested persons will have an opportunity to appear and be heard in relation to the following:

## LAND USE CODE AMENDMENT – MOTOR VEHICLE AND BICYCLE PARKING REQUIREMENTS

The proposed text amendment revises the City of Tucson Code, Chapter 23, Land Use Code (LUC) and the City of Tucson Development Standards, pertaining to the motor vehicle and bicycle parking requirements. The proposed amendment includes revisions to the required number of motor vehicle and bicycle parking spaces, the permitted reductions and exceptions to the required number of parking spaces, and the motor vehicle use area and bicycle parking design criteria. The proposed amendment also establishes motor vehicle stacking requirements, a process allowing administrative modifications to the parking dimensional requirements, and fees for the aforementioned modification process and a bicycle parking in-lieu fee.

The proposed amendment to the LUC would occur in Article III, Development Regulations, Division 3, Motor Vehicle and Bicycle Parking Requirements, Article V, Administration, Division 3, Special Development Applications, and Article VI, Definitions, Division 2, Listing of Words and Terms. The proposed amendments to the Development Standards would occur in Sections 1-05, Development Review Fee Schedule, 2-09, Bicycle Parking Facility Design Requirements, 3-01, Street Development Standard, 3-05, Vehicular Use Area Design Criteria, and 12-01, Establishment and Revision History. Other sections of the LUC and the Development Standards will be amended to replace section references resulting from the proposed amendments to the motor vehicle and bicycle parking requirements.

## LAND USE CODE AMENDMENT – OFF-STREET LOADING

The proposed text amendment revises the City of Tucson Code, Chapter 23, Land Use Code (LUC) Article III, Development Regulations, Division 4, Off-Street Loading and Division 7, Landscaping and Screening Regulations. The proposed amendment includes revisions to the required number of loading areas for certain uses and the loading area design criteria and dimensional requirements. Other sections of the LUC will be amended to replace references to Off-Street Loading with the new Loading Areas name.
